SUMMARY

This weekend Pastor Billy taught a message entitled, “It’s Always Too Soon To Quit”. In this message, we looked at Acts 18:1-11 where we find Paul starting a new work in the city of Corinth. It’s in this passage that Paul finds some important friends - a husband and wife team named Aquila and Priscilla - as well as some opposition from some Jews. In the end, a new church is started and Paul is encouraged by God.

APPLICATION

- 1. The Lord provided friends**
 - Read verses 1-3 and describe the type of friends that the Lord brought to Paul.
 - Talk about a time in life when God brought you a much needed friend.
- 2. The Lord provided resources**
 - Read verses 4-5 and discuss what type of resources God brought to Paul.
 - How have you seen the Lord provided the resources you need (whether human resources or financial resources)?
 - Are there any needs that you’re trusting God to provided the resources for? If so, what?
- 3. God’s work is always opposed**
 - Read verses 6-7. What was the Jew’s response to Paul’s proclamation of Jesus?
 - How have you experienced opposition as you’ve joined in God’s work?
 - If you’re currently experiencing opposition, how can this group pray for you?
- 4. The Lord provided followers**
 - Read verse 8. Who is now following Jesus as a result of Paul’s proclamation of the gospel?
 - Have you ever shared the gospel with someone and they started following Jesus? If so, who was it and what happened?
 - Is there anyone you are feeling lead to share the gospel with? Is so, how will you respond?
- 5. The Lord is faithful to replace fearfulness with fearlessness.**
 - Read verses 9-10 and then describe the things that the Lord told Paul in a vision.
 - What areas of your life presently do you struggle with fear?
 - This week, how can you trust God to replace your fearfulness with fearlessness?

PRAYER

Pray for those in this small group who are experiencing opposition or fear.
