### KICKOFF

Describe the perfect day.

### SUMMARY

Pastor Kenny taught a message entitled *Can I Get a Witness* from Acts 21:37-22:24. In this passage we saw how Paul, when given the opportunity, shared his story of meeting Jesus. We learned four lessons about how we can grow in this important area of witnessing.

#### 1. Be poised and proactive (read Acts 21:37-40)

- Paul was clearly prepared to share the gospel when the opportunity presented itself. If you were in a similar situation, how well prepared would you be to share your testimony?
- What can you do to be better prepared to share your story of meeting Christ when you have the chance?

#### 2. Consider the audience (read Acts 22:1-4)

- Paul understood the perspectives of the people to whom he was speaking. Why is it so important to understand the worldview of the person with whom you're sharing the gospel?
- How can you learn about the perspectives of those with whom you hope to share the gospel?

### APPLICATION

#### 3. Center upon your conversion (read Acts 22:5-20)

- While Paul did highlight his life before his conversion, he made much of his experience of meeting Jesus. Why is it tempting to talk a lot about our life before Christ?
- As a group, talk about your conversation stories and what happened when you met Jesus?

#### 4. Be open-handed with the outcome (read Acts 22:21-23)

- In reality, not everyone will accept the message of the gospel. How can continue to become someone who is faithful to share truth while trusting God with outcome?

### PRAYER

Pray that God would give us opportunities in the near future to share the gospel with another person.
