SUMMARY

APPLICATION

1. Some things must end (v.22)

- Instead of simply *enduring* your trial, how can you *employ* your trial?

3. Watch out - the devil will do anything he can to get you isolated and alone (v.30)

- Why is isolation one of the devil’s main weapons against us?
- How can you, in 2018, surround yourself more with godly people?

4. Relational health is a sign of spiritual health (v.36-38)

- Generally speaking, how are your relationships?
- What is one thing that you can do in 2018 to grow in your relational health?

Pray that God would empower those in the group that need to end some things in 2018.
